



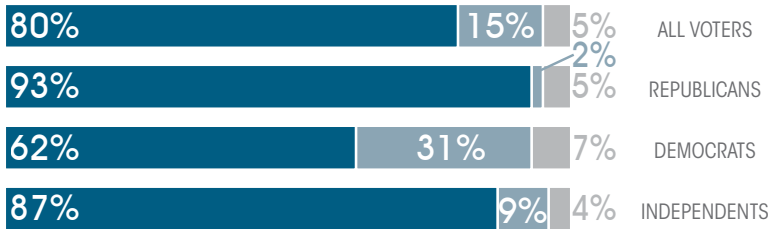

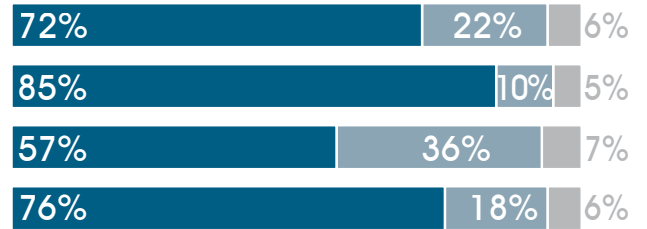
Voters support work requirements for welfare benefits

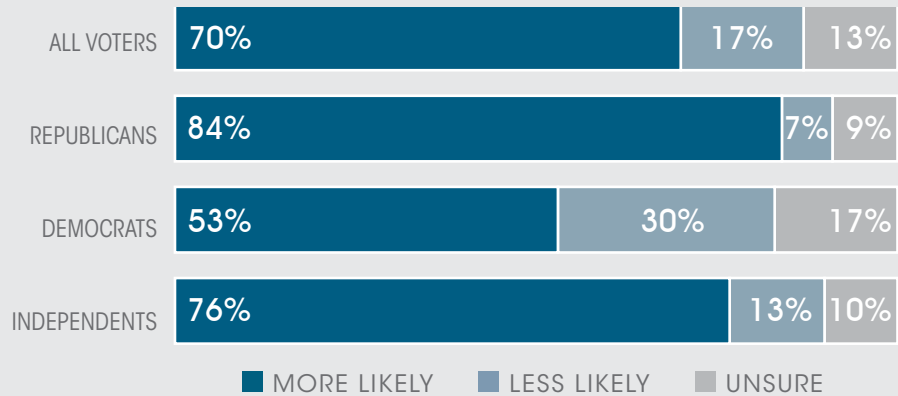

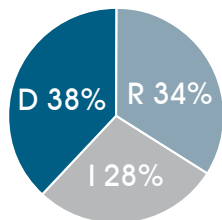
Voters are more likely to support reformers



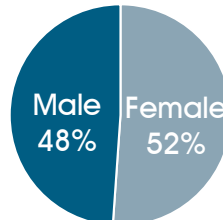
■ MORE LIKELY ■ LESS LIKELY ■ UNSURE

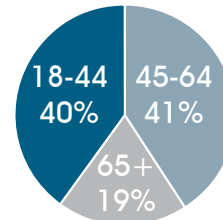

Results for this poll are based on live telephone interviews conducted among 350 likely voters. Data for this survey research was collected by Cor Strategies Inc. The surveys were conducted March 19, 2018. The margin of sampling error is plus or minus 5.24 percentage points. The margin of sampling error may be higher for certain subgroups. Results presented may not always appear to total 100 percent due to rounding.

Data was sampled using weighted demographic information and actual voters in past elections were used to construct sample target weights.
