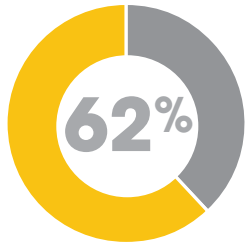




Food Stamp Work Requirements

THE PROBLEM: RECORD NUMBERS OF ABLE-BODIED ADULTS ARE ON FOOD STAMPS

The number of able-bodied adults on food stamps remains near record highs, despite a booming economy. **Without any real work requirement, these adults will remain trapped in dependency.**




62 percent of able-bodied adults on food stamps **don't work at all.**




This takes resources away from the truly needy, such as seniors and individuals with disabilities.

THE SOLUTION: WORK REQUIREMENTS

States should require able-bodied adults to:


Work

Train

OR


Volunteer

for an average of eight hours per week.
