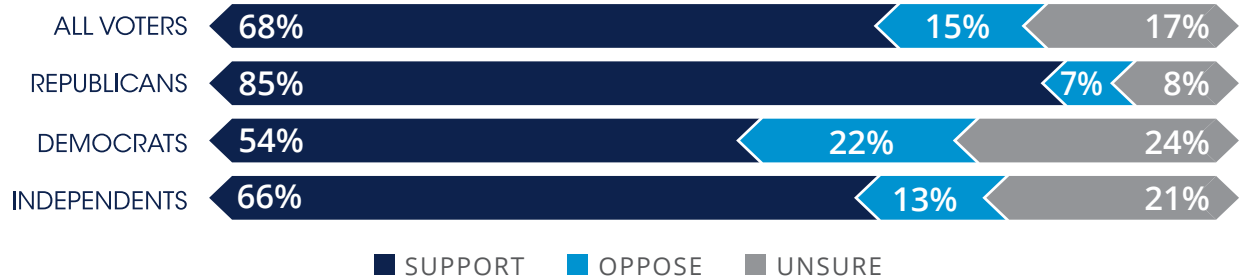

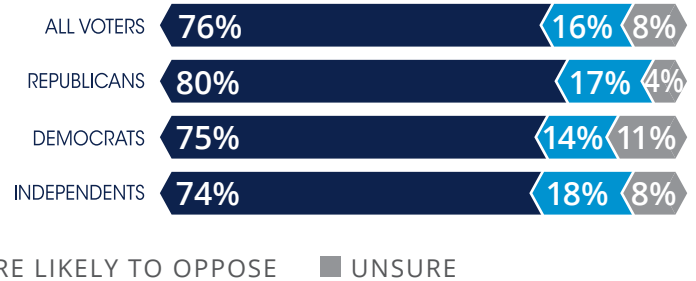
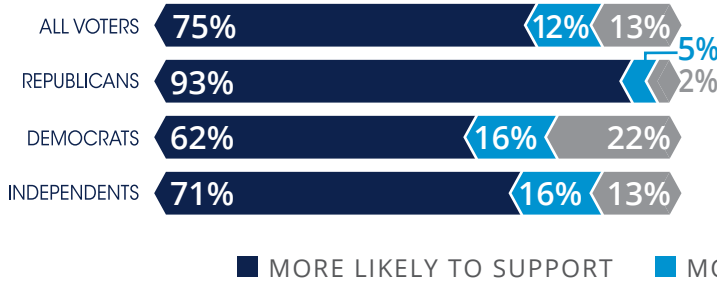
## AMERICAN VOTERS SUPPORT ELECTION INTEGRITY

Voters support improving election integrity by closing loopholes in election laws that erode trust in the election process.

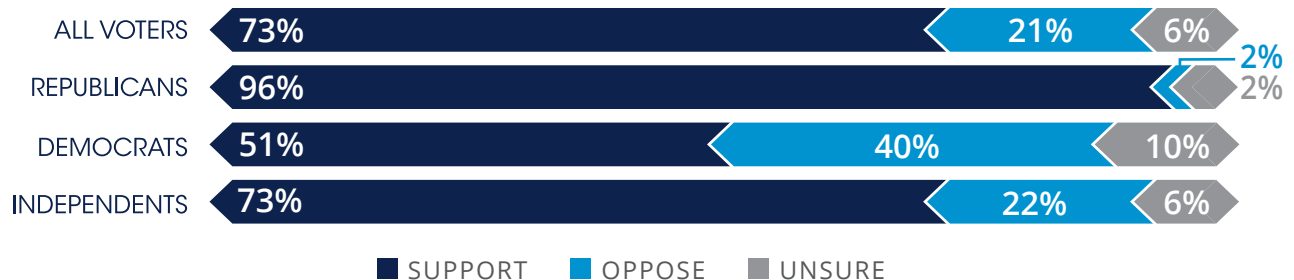


Voters want to strengthen laws to prosecute unelected bureaucrats who mishandle or tamper with elections.

Voters appreciate that election integrity reform would protect low-income voters against fraud.



Voters support requiring presentation of a government-issued photo identification when they vote in person to verify that they are who they say they are.

# THE JOHN LEWIS VOTING RIGHTS ADVANCEMENT ACT

Voters are less likely to support the John Lewis Voting Rights Advancement Act, S.4263, when they know:

**63%** LESS LIKELY TO SUPPORT It encourages **special interest groups and elected officials to conspire together** to weaken voting safeguards.

**58%** LESS LIKELY TO SUPPORT It allows federal officials to **directly target certain states and override the will of the voters.**

**57%** LESS LIKELY TO SUPPORT It helps **special interest groups get what they want** by engaging in costly lawsuits.

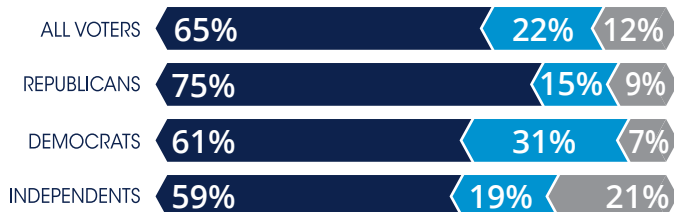
**52%** LESS LIKELY TO SUPPORT It **allows D.C. bureaucrats to overrule state election laws** without due process.

**51%** LESS LIKELY TO SUPPORT It could lead to **more costly and more frequent court battles** that impact election outcomes.

## LIVESTREAMING BALLOT CENTERS

Voters are more likely to support livestreaming at ballot counting centers when they know:

It could help **restore some of the public's trust in our election system** and processes.



It could help **stop people from wanting to tamper** with ballots and vote-counting machines.

## ABSENTEE BALLOT WITNESS SIGNATURE

Voters are more likely to support requiring a witness for absentee ballots when they know:

It could help ensure **bad actors can't pretend to be someone else** and vote in their name.



It could **protect the ballots of elderly voters** who live in long-term health care facilities.

## VERIFYING VOTER ROLLS TWICE YEARLY

Voters are more likely to support verifying the voter rolls when they know:

It could help ensure **people who have moved are properly notified** that they need to update their voter registration.



It could help **prevent voter identity theft**.

## BEST MESSAGES ON BIDEN EXECUTIVE ORDER ON ELECTIONS (AKA FEDERAL TAKEOVER OF ELECTIONS)

**64%** OF VOTERS

either **initially oppose or are unsure what they think about the president's political power grab.**

American voters are **even less likely to support** the president's political power grab when they know...

**62%**

it could **create loopholes that permit election fraud**, such as people double voting or people voting who are ineligible to vote.



it could mean **more voter registration applications are mailed out** than there are Americans who are eligible to vote.

the federal government **would be able to override state election laws.**



it could **transfer control over local and national elections** from the states and give that power to the federal government.
