



Inflation is costing families an additional

Congress **can tame inflation** by requiring costly regulations, guidance, and other agency actions to receive congressional approval before taking effect **with the REINS Act**.




In the U.S. overall, prices have increased **13.5 percent**, costing the average American household \$728 last month alone.*
